



Kenton Streetscape Design Workshop

More than 40 Kenton neighbors and city staff gathered at the December 6th Denver Avenue Design Workshop. During the four-hour workshop, participants rated the existing Denver streetscape against goals and criteria developed by the citizen's advisory committee (CAC) including safety, neighborhood identity, retail vitality and environmental impact. Participants then viewed examples of streetscape designs from around the world, and went on to develop three broad conceptual design options for Denver Avenue streetscape improvements.

The 14-person (CAC) has been working with PDC, PDOT and consultants SERA Architects and Greenworks on the Kenton Streetscape project. They previously toured six different streetscapes in the Portland area to get ideas of what potential streetscape elements might be and worked with city staff on an on-site Field Day to verify existing conditions.
