Regarding: Update on the Lents Town Center Urban Renewal Area Transportation Task Force
Date: November 2, 2009

At the September 8, 2009 Lents Town Center Urban Renewal Advisory Committee (LTC URAC) meeting, the URAC requested an update on the formation of the LTC URA Transportation Task Force (TTF).

PDC staff carefully considered the recommendation made by the LTC URAC of having nine members on the TTF: four LTC URAC representatives, and one representative each from the following neighborhood associations: Lents, Powellhurst-Gilbert, Foster-Powell, Mt. Scott-Arleta, and Brentwood-Darlington. Staff will also invite one representative each from the Foster Area Business Association and the 82nd Avenue of Roses Business Association, and two at-large representatives: one from the residents and one from the businesses in the URA. The total number of TTF members would then be 13.

Staff sent e-mail messages to the LTC URAC members, and to the above-mentioned neighborhood association chairs, requesting the names of people who would be interested in serving on the TTF. Here is a list of the TTF positions and names collected so far:
